



RULES AND REGULATIONS

These Rules shall be called the rules of which shall herein after be referred to as the Rules of the Trust.

DEFINITION:

- (a) "Authorities" mean the authorities of the Trust
- (b) "Government" means the Government of the Countries.
- (c) "Chairman" means the Managing Trustee of the Trust.
- (d) "Director" means the Director of the Trust.
- (e) "Board of Management" means the Board of Management of the Trust.
- (f) "Year" Means the financial year.
- (g) "Planning Committee" means the Planning Committee of the Trust.
- (h) "Finance Committee" means the Finance Committee of the Trust.
- (i) "Advisory Committee" means of the Advisory Committee of the Trust.

THE FOLLOWING SHALL BE THE AUTHORITIES OF THE TURST

- a) Board of Management.
- b) Any such other authorities as may be deemed necessary by the Board of management from time to time.

TERMS OF MEMBERSHIP:

The Trust shall be managed by Managing Trustee under the guidance of Board of Trustees. Other than Board of management other Trustees, if any, shall hold office for terms of **three years** and shall be eligible for re-appointment. Trustee for life shall be entitled to nominate their successors to office of the trustees and in the event of a vacancy arising in the office of a trustee for life, the managing trustees should nominate successor of the life trustee causing vacancy in his/her place. The managing trustee of the trust shall have, subject to the control, direction and superintendence of the Board of Trustees, all any every power for the purpose of managing, conducting and administering the affairs of the Trust and the institutions and establishments, owned, run or conducted by the Trust. The board of Trustees shall be competent to transact every and all business by the majority. The managing trustee shall have the casting vote.

SELECTION OF THE NOMINEES:

The founder Trustees unanimously will be selected nominees for the committee as decided by the board of management.

MEETING OF THE BOARD

- a) That Board of Management shall meet at least two times in a year or at such time as required by the trust. Not less than 15 days' notice shall be given of a meeting of the Board of Management. In case of urgency, the meeting may be called by the Chairman/Chairperson/Chairperson and the notice time will be according to the situation.
- b) Each member of the above body including the Chairman/Chairperson shall have one vote and decision at the meeting of the Board shall be taken by the majority. In case of a tie, the Chairman/Chairperson shall have a casting vote.
- c) Every meeting of the above body shall be presided over the Chairman/Chairperson and in his/her absence member respective to preside the meeting.

Any Business necessary may be carried out by circulatory an appropriate resolution among its member and resolution so circulated and approved by simple majority shall be as effective and binding as if such resolution had been passed at the meeting of the board of the Management.

POWER AND FUNCTION OF MANAGEMENT OF BOARD

The Board of Management shall be the principal executive body of the Trust and except as provided otherwise in the Rule/Bye-Laws, shall exercise all power vested in it and do all such acts as may be exercise or done by the Drawing and disbursing authority" will upon the President and the treasurer respectively Trust.

- a) To manage and regulate the Finance and investments of funds, property and all other administrative affairs of the Trust and for that purpose to appoint such agent as it may deem fit.
- b) To entertain and adjudicate upon and if thought fit to redress any grievances of the employees.
- c) To select an emblem and to have a common seal for the Trust and to provide for the custody and use of such seal.
- d) To Institute fellowship, scholarship, medals and prizes on the advice of the finance committee.
- e) To appoint such committees for such purposes and with such powers as the Board of Management may think necessary and to co-opt such persons on these committee as it may think fit.
- f) To appoint Auditors for the ensuing years.
- g) To open account of the Trust with any one or more scheduled banks and to lay down the procedure for operating the same.
- h) To issue appeals for funds consistent with the object of the Trust, to receive grants, donations, contribution, gift, prizes, scholarship and other money to give grants and donations, to award prized, scholarships etc.
- i) To draw, accept, make endorse discount and negotiable promissory notes, bills of exchanges, cheques etc.
- j) To transfer or accept any movable/immovable property on behalf of the Trust.
- k) To provide building or buildings, premises, furniture, fittings, equipment's, appliances and other facilities required for carrying on the work of the Trust.

- l) To deposit all money and credited to the fund in schedule bank/banks or to invest them in consultation with the finance committee.
- m) To maintain proper accounts and other relevant record and prepare annual statement of account of every previous financial year, in such for as may be prescribed by the Regulations/Bye Laws.
- n) To the Managing Trustee/Founder have power that appointed new member or member leaved.
- o) To delegate all or any of its powers to any committee constituted by it or agent/agents etc.
- p) President & Secretary share equal voting power, requiring unanimous decisions.

FUNDS, ACCOUNTS, AUDIT

- a) The account of Trust shall be maintained in the name of the Trust. The accounts of the Trust shall be kept in such forms as may be laid down by the Board of the Management. It shall conform to the rules, if any prescribed by the respective governments, wherever the accounts are opened and maintained.
- b) The funds of the trust shall be utilized solely for the purpose of the Trust.
- c) Annual report and the Audit reports shall be submitted to the board of Management within **three months** closure of the accounting year for the needful.
- d) That regular account will be maintained relating to all receipts, payment, Income, Expenditure or any property relating to the trust. Further, accounts of the trust will be audited by an Chartered Accountant as defined in the explanation before sub-section 2 of the section 288 as to fulfill the conditions of Section-12 A (b) / 80G, 35 AC I II , of the income Tax Act, 1961, or any rules and regulations made there-under or any amendment or modification thereof.

BANKING NORMS

Settler/Founder of the Trust or any other member together with the Settler/Founder authorized by the Board of Management of the Trust can Open or operate bank accounts in the name of the Trust.

INTERPREATION CLAUSE

In the event of confusion, contradiction and conflicts of opinion with regard to interpretation of Charter Trust or rules and bye-laws the opinion of the funder Trustee of the Board of management shall prevail.

AND

DISSOLUTION

On the dissolution of the Trust, the Property shall not be paid or distributed among the members of the Trust but shall be donated to any other organization having similar aims and property whatsoever.
